

### Anniversary Banquet

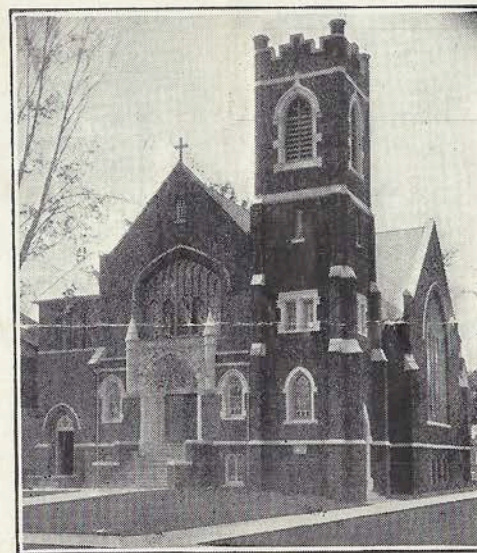
